## Brigadier General Mark T. McQueen

Commander, 350th Civil Affairs Command

Brigadier General Mark T. McQueen graduated as an ROTC Distinguished Military Graduate from Auburn University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Finance. He was commissioned in the Regular Army a U.S. Army Second Lieutenant in the Adjutant General's Corps.

His subsequent military education includes: the Adjutant General's Corps Basic and Advanced Course, the Combined Arms Services Staff School, Command and General Staff College, the Army War College, and the National Security Studies Program. Brigadier General McQueen also earned a Master of Science in Counseling and Human Development from Troy State University and a Masters degree in Strategic Studies from the United States Army War College.

He has served in numerous duty assignments both in the United States and overseas. Some of these include the 1st Armor Division in Germany, the 361st Civil Affairs Brigade in Pensacola and also in support of OPERATION CONSTANT GUARD in Bosnia. Also as a primary staff officer for the 352nd Civil Affairs Command in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM in Baghdad. He has commanded the 412th Civil Affairs Battalion, the 321st Civil Affairs Brigade and the 1st Brigade of the 75th Division before his assignment as the Commanding General of the 350th Civil Affairs Command.
